





2016-2017




2018-2019


On 16th October 2019, **Diwali Mela**, 'Shubanjali' was organized.

On the occasion of **World Mental Health Day**, Department of Psychology organized a lecture cum discussion 'Aftermath of Pandemic... what lies ahead.'


